In the event that there are more images, the Selection Committee will make the decision as to which images represent WACCO. The selection committee consists of Gerry Emmerich, Kathy Braun and Joe Haertle. WACCO has come in last the past two years. After winning the first year, WACCO has come in last place the prior two years. We would like to improve our showing. Please encourage your members to participate with their finest work.

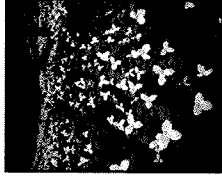

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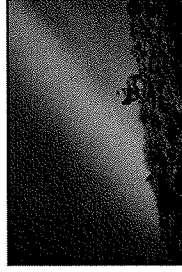

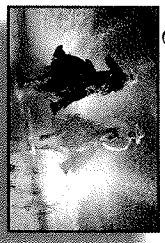
